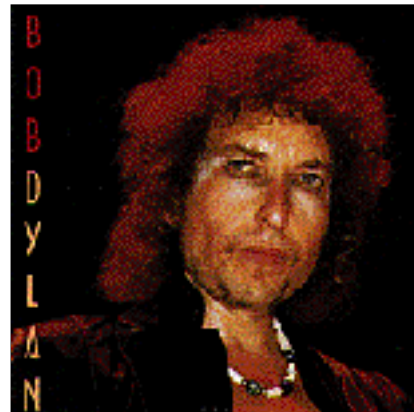

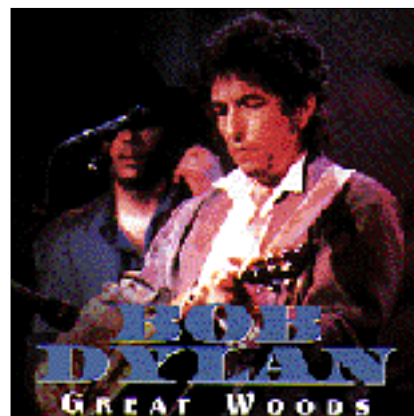

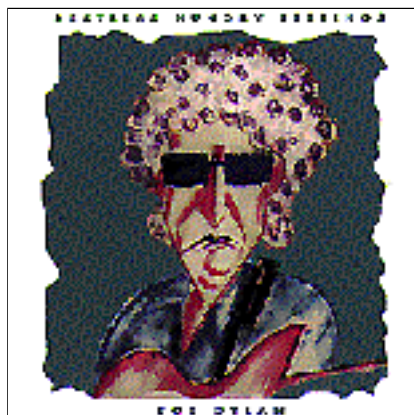

Not to be confused with former releases of the same/similar titles. Superb recording of the complete Fort Worth concert, supplemented with 2 additional tracks (†) that have been added into the performance extending the main recording. Though no doubt a controversial move from an 'historic' viewpoint, as a listening experience it works phenomenally well. Recording is an improvement on earlier releases - even if you have them this one is worth consideration, if you don't it's a must!
